Contestant Rules

1. Legacy Club® at Circa Resort & Casino will host a \$5,000 costume contest (Haunted Heights) on Saturday, October 31, 2026, beginning at 8:00 PM with the contest beginning at 10:00 PM.

7. Management will be on hand to assure the adherence to contest rules and to disqualify contestants that refused to adhere to the rules.
8. The winning contestant will be responsible for the applicable taxes.
